Develop lasting relationships with families and kids. Join us for weekly play dates, fun excursions, block parties, special events, or our annual International Kids Kamp.






BABY PARTNERSHIPS

TRAUMA GROUPS

Our refugee youth and adults have been through layers of trauma having run from their homeland and resettled into an unknown country, language, and culture. Our trauma care program seeks to build community, conversations and skills to cope with the past in order to thrive in the future. Developed by professionals in the field, this 8 week curriculum helps people deal with their own trauma, recognize trauma in others and how to help their children cope on their way to resilience from traumatic situations.
